USES

MOSSBOSS is a safe, efficient material for the elimination of moss, mould, mildew, and lichen from most surfaces. It can be used on roofs, pathways, patios, decks, fences, weather boards and outdoor furniture. It is effective, environmentally friendly and biodegradable.

APPLICATION:

Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not apply if rain is expected within 12 hours.

Add 1 part of MOSSBOSS to 4 parts of clean water.

5 Litres of MOSSBOSS makes 25 Litres of usable product, or 20 Litres of MOSSBOSS makes 100 Litres of usable product.

Stir well to ensure complete mixing.

Best applied in dry, overcast conditions with a low-pressure garden sprayer.

Thoroughly saturate the surface and leave for a few days. Remove the dead growth with a stiff brush, high pressure hose or simply let it wear away with the weather. MOSSBOSS does not show immediate results, but it works slowly and effectively without damaging the surface.

ROOFS:

If the roof is used to collect drinking water, disconnect tank inlet pipes until the roof has had at least 6 mm of rain. This may be a period of 2-4 weeks.

COVERAGE:

Coverage will depend on the amount of growth to be cleaned. On porous surfaces 1 litre will cover approximately 5 square metres and up to 10 square metres on non-porous surfaces.

CALITION:

When applying MOSSBOSS to your roof, it is always best to employ an approved applicator to undertake the work for you, as walking around on roofs can be dangerous. Also, householders unfamiliar with working at height pose a considerable risk of injury to themselves by falling from ladders or the roof. 












DANGER:
